Year 3 have made excellent progress in their swimming lessons at Exhall Grange School:

- **Groups 1 and 2** have successfully completed their swimming programme and received certificates celebrating their achievements.
- **Group 3** will continue with lessons after Christmas to complete their course.

Throughout the term, pupils have developed confidence in the water, improved a range of swimming strokes, and learned essential self-rescue skills.
