Our association is about much more than simply fundraising. Wheelwright Lane Parent's Association *exists* to provide closer links between home and school and it is an excellent way to bring staff, parents and friends together socially in support of the school, working towards a common goal. We have recently organised a local community event through Happy's Circus. Over 600 people from the local area visited the school site to watch the circus, eat and spend time as a community.

All parents and members of the school community are encouraged to get involved, even if they only have a small amount of time available. It is a great way to make new friends and form strong links with our community.

Funds are not generally spent on improving the fabric of the school building, as this is the responsibility of the school. We are committed to spending money on things that will benefit the children directly.

How we keep you up to date

We input into the school newsletter which is send out by email every Tuesday, this includes information on upcoming events and dates plus details of help we are looking for at lager events. Following an event, we always write to let you know how much was raised, and when we reach our target, we tell you what the money will be spent on.
