Administering Medication

School staff are able to administer prescribed medication as directed by a health professional. Warwickshire Safe Haven

Please note that there is a new drop-in service in Nuneaton for adults and teens over 16 experiencing emotional distress. Clients can drop in if they a just feeling a bit low or lonely, or if they are feeling suicidal and really depressed at the other end of the scale.

The service offers a cup of tea and chat, signposting and a 24 hour helpline staffed by trained counsellors.

The drop-in is situated in the Newtown Centre (next to the bus station) in Nuneaton and is open Thursday to Sunday 6 pm - 11 pm each night.

There is a phone number that clients can ring any evening (including Monday to Wednesday) to get support. Please see attached for further details.

There will be another Safe Haven opening up in Coventry soon - further details to follow.
