We are looking forward to welcoming all children back from tomorrow.

In line with Warwickshire Authority guidance our school will be open from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January for ALL children. As you are aware we follow Government and Authority guidance - if this guidance changes you will be contacted immediately by text in order to make further arrangements.

Our Risk Assessment remains in place and all procedures will continue as in previous months. We will continue to use the staggered start and finish times as follows:

Early Years - Reception and Nursery Start: 8.45 (doors open at 8.40)Finish 3.15 Years 1 and 2 Start: 9.05 Finish: 3.00 Years 3 and 4 Start: 8.55 Finish : 3.10

Start: 8.55 Finish : 3.10

Years 5 and 6

Start: 8.45(Skamps entrance)Finish 3.20

If you are coming on to school grounds then you must use a face covering - I know that many of you already do and I thank you for your care and understanding. We all recognise the importance of protecting parents and staff from this current more virulent infection. I can only run the school if the staff stay well -I have no extra support staff to cover - please help the school by doing all that you can to protect yourselves, your children and staff.

Any child that is unable to attend school for health or self-isolating reasons will be expected to use the TEAMs for home learning. Tapestry will be used for Early Years. For all other year groups work will be set on TEAMs. Please check this daily. Face to face teaching will commence w.c. 11<sup>th</sup>

#### Covid Winter Grant Scheme

The Government has recently made available Winter Scheme funding to COVID-19 Grant support those most in need across England with the cost of food, energy, water bills and other essentials. This funding is ring-fenced and available from December until the end of March 2021 for Warwickshire families and individuals facing hardship during this winter. The objective of the COVID-19 Winter Grant Scheme is to provide support to vulnerable households and families with children particularly affected by the pandemic throughout the winter period where alternative sources of assistance may be unavailable. The council will be administering the allocation from the COVID-19 Winter Grant Scheme through the Local Welfare Scheme
