Infection and transmission

Schools in Bedworth and near to us in Coventry are still sending bubbles of children home due to coronavirus infection in children and staff. Please can I ask that you remain vigilant and stick to the stay at home message and social distancing - the last thing we want is to send

the children home due to the infection being brought in to school. Just a reminder that if your child is ill with any of the symptoms then please keep them off school and, if needed, take a test (Tests are available from school).

Thank you for wearing face coverings and social distancing whilst on school site. We are all doing everything we can to keep infection rates down within our community - none of us want to go back to children not coming in to school again. Masks are a key measure to suppress transmission and save lives - please think of others (you do not know the underlying conditions of the person standing next to you - you may be putting them at risk). Please keep up the good work.

Positive Covid-19 cases

Schools are part of the Government's Test and Trace system and are required to inform them of any positive cases that come in to school. We know that adults and children's symptoms appear between day 3 and day 7 of being around an infected person. Therefore, if any of your children test positive for 7 days after Thursday 1st April (up to and including Wednesday 7th April) please let me know as I will need to report to Test and Trace.
