Wraparound Care

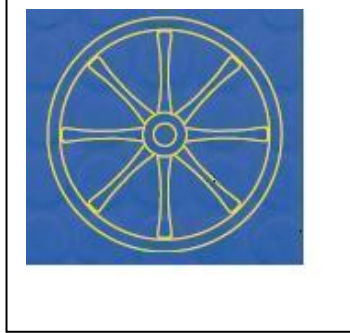
The school continues to provide emergency wraparound care for families. We will be reviewing the provision for September over the next few weeks. Information will be available towards the end of term.

Musical Instrument Tuition

If your child would like to learn to play the guitar or keyboard next September and will be in Year 3 - 6 please see the attached letter for more information.

Dear Parent/Carer

An exciting opportunity is available for your child to start instrumental music tuition in school for children in Year's 3 to 6 which starts in September 2021.

Weekly lessons can be provided and a will be provided in the course of the academic year. These will be paid for in advance at half termly intervals at a cost of approximately £25 per half term (subject to uptake) online via SIMspay. Unfortunately no deductions can be made for pupil's absence except where their absence was a result of another school activity.

It is probable that an instrument can be provided in the first year by the County Music Service through applications made online (further details will follow if you wish your child to have tuition). After that pupils will be required to provide their own. Parents will need to provide all necessary music and **must give a term's notice to terminate lessons or pay a term's fee in lieu of notice**. Please note that the school is required to pay tuition fees for the whole year in advance and must recoup their loss if children fail to continue.

The school reserves the right to terminate lessons if appropriate.

If you are interested in your child receiving tuition, please complete the slip below and return to school asap. Places are limited and will be offered on a first come first serve basis with priority given to those children already receiving tuition.
