School Procedures for Covid cases

I am again attaching the close contacts information regarding Covid-19 for your information. Children under the age of 18 and those over the age of 18 that have been double vaccinated ARE allowed in school as long as they are well and do not show Covid symptoms. If we have a positive case in school (adult or child) we will identify those who have been in close contact (as in the information leaflet) and let parents/carers know. It will not be necessary to close down

whole class bubbles as in the past, prevaccination days. We will endeavor to keep children in school as long as we can.

Remote Learning will support those children who are unable to come in to school and your child's class teacher will contact you regarding work to be completed.

School Trips

We are pleased to confirm that the children are now able to enjoy school trips. On the 29th September pupils in Year 1 will be visiting Ash End Farm and on 1st October Year 6 pupils will be visiting Coventry Cathedral and the Herbert Art Gallery. Payment for school trips can be make via Sims360. If you are experiencing any problems accessing SIMS360 please contact the school office.

Inhalers and medical arrangements

Please make sure that your child has an inhaler in school if needed. Most of these were sent home in June/July for home use. Also please inform the office for any other medical updates.

Pupil Premium and FSM

The Government Universal Free School Meal initiative (not to be confused with free school meal - Pupil Premium grant - see below) launched on 1st September 2014 states that all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 have their lunches free and provided by the school

We positively promote this and encourage all parents to take up this offer. We estimate that it will save parents £400 per year and provide children with a well-balanced and nutritious lunch.

Pupil Premium grant also gives children an entitlement to a free school meal along with other benefits. If you are on low income and/or receiving benefits then please apply for this grant as the school receives extra income towards its education budget for your child.

Even if your child is currently receiving free school meals because they are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, you should still apply for benefits-related FSM if you think you may be eligible.

Doing so means that your child's school will be given extra funding for six years, which can help to fund valuable teaching and learning support for your school.

Applying for benefits-related FSM also means you will be eligible to receive funding for the holiday periods from the <u>Warwickshire Local</u> Welfare Scheme.

Key rings on school bags

Children are bringing in 'key rings with toys' on their bags and back packs. Children are finding them irresistible to play with as they pass them in the corridor throughout the day and at the beginning of the day. Please do not send these in as they are becoming a huge distraction for the children.

Holiday club

I am pleased to announce that Nuneaton and Bedworth Leisure Trust will be running a sports/arts/craft club at the school in holiday times. This will start in the October half term and further dates will be available. There will be special rates for the October half term as an introductory offer. I will send out the leaflets and information when they arrive this week.

This club will also be available for children who do not attend this school so please book early to make sure you reserve a place - it will be very popular.

Cool Milk

Free milk is available for all children aged under five in school, funded by the UK government.

In our school, this milk is provided by Cool Milk, the UK's leading school milk supplier.

When your child turns five, you are able to pay a subsidised rate for your child to continue to receive milk. If you wish for your child to continue receiving milk from the age of five, simply register with Cool Milk directly via their website (www.coolmilk.com). They will then contact you at the appropriate time to arrange pre-payment.

Flu Immunisations

The Nasal Flu Vaccination will take place in school on **Tuesday 21**st **September** for Years Reception to Year 6 inclusive.

The immunisation team have advised that consent forms are online. A letter has been sent via Teachers2Parents providing more information. When your form has been successfully uploaded you will receive a confirmation reference number from the immunisation team.
