Attendance

It is expected that all children will attend school unless they are unwell with the usual illnesses that affect them. If children display Covid-19 symptoms: high temperature, persistent cough and loss of taste and smell then please keep them off school and arrange for a PCR test to confirm if positive or negative. **If Covid is in the household then please obtain PCR for all of the household and only send your child in to school when they receive their negative result.**

School Procedures for Covid cases

The school follows guidance from PHE and the DfE as follows: Children under the age of 18 and those over the age of 18 that have been double vaccinated ARE allowed in school as long as they are well and do not show Covid symptoms. If we have a positive case in school (adult or child) we will identify those who have been in close contact (as in the information leaflet) and let parents/carers know. It will not be necessary to close down whole class bubbles as in the past, pre-vaccination days. We will endeavor to keep children in school as long as we can. Remote Learning will support those children who are unable to come in to school and your child's class teacher will contact you regarding work to be completed.

The rate of infection in the area remains extremely high. If you feel safer wearing masks whilst on the school site then please do so - anything that helps keep the rate down will help.
