## Latest DFe/PHE guidance for Covid cases

The guidance again has changed from Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> January. This is the latest information from the DFE- there is a change to requesting the PCR test so please read the information carefully:

### 'Temporary suspension of confirmatory PCR tests in education and childcare settings

Confirmatory PCR testing following a positive result on a lateral flow device (LFD) will be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January. This means that for all education and childcare settings, staff and students who have tested (either at home or through ATS) and reported a positive LFD result will no longer be advised to get a confirmatory PCR test.

This change is informed by public health advice. With high COVID-19 rates, the risk of a positive LFD result being false is very small. We therefore don't need to ask people to do a confirmatory PCR unless they:

have symptoms (in which case they need to follow the stay at home guidance, self-isolate and order a PCR test)

wish to claim the Test and Trace Support Payment

have been advised to take a PCR test because they are in a clinically vulnerable group

have been advised to do so as part of a research or surveillance programme

Education and childcare settings are not expected to trace contacts of a positive case

as this will remain the responsibility of NHS Test and Trace. From Tuesday 11 January, contact tracing is triggered once a positive LFD test is reported.

Students should be strongly encouraged to test twice weekly at home and to report all results to NHS Test and Trace and to their setting. Anyone with a positive LFD test result should self-isolate and follow self-isolation guidance.

New guidance: Children/adults are now able to come back to school after 5 days of having positive test as long as they test on day 5 (a.m.) and day 6 (a.m.). If 24 hours of negative results then able to return to school on day 6.

Remote Learning will support those children who are unable to come in to school and your child's class teacher will contact you regarding work to be completed.

If you feel safer wearing masks whilst on the school site then please do so - anything that helps keep the rate down will help.

We await further guidance at the end of this week. However, cases in school have never been so high. We are continuing to follow our safety measures to minimize transmission.

## Gas works being carried out outside school

Express Utilities will be carrying out essential gas works outside school this may involve the use of two way temporary traffic lights on Wheelwright Lane.
