

Latest DFe/PHE guidance for Covid cases

Government guidance changed on 24th February and we will be following the advice and guidance from the Local Authority as follows:

If anyone shows signs of Covid we ask that they get a PCR test and, if positive, stay at home for 5 days. They should test using LFDs on day 5 and 6 and make sure that these are negative before returning to school.

Close contacts do not need to do daily LFD testing but be mindful if any symptoms occur and get a PCR test to confirm.

We have been asked to continue to advise if anyone is a close contact of a positive case so

that you can keep an eye on your child and take action if they develop symptoms.

Headteachers are also being asked to monitor rates of positive cases and are expected to follow the DFe guidance below regarding attendance:

'In most cases, parents and carers will agree that a pupil with the key symptoms of COVID-19 should not attend the school, given the potential risk to others.

If a parent or carer insists on a pupil attending your school where they have a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19, you (HT) can take the decision to refuse the pupil if, in your reasonable judgement, it is necessary to protect other pupils and staff from possible infection with COVID-19.'

If your child is ill then we will expect them to stay at home and follow the guidance for positive cases.

We are expecting further guidance on 1st April.

Please note: If children are unwell we do not expect them to complete work at home - we would like them to rest and recover. Please see our Continuity of Learning Policy on the website for further details and support for parents.
