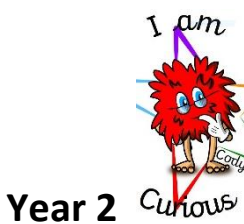

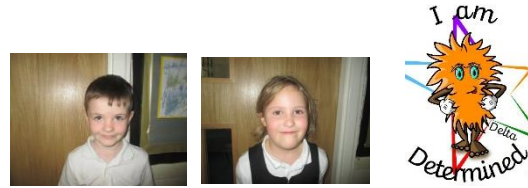
### Learning at Wheelwright Lane last week.

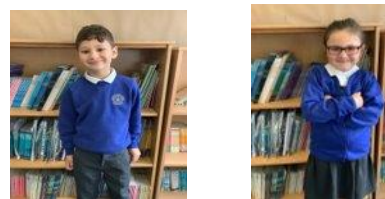


Jaxon and Mimi have been amazing learners this week. They have shown fantastic determination throughout the week and not giving up when things get tricky. Well done!



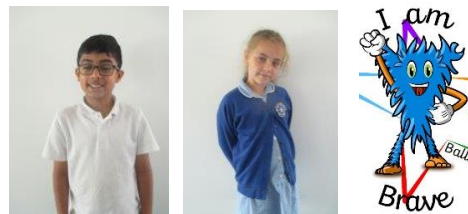
#### Year 3
