home. As the children move trhough the year groups, reading homework changes. We really would encourage you to come along and find out about how you can support your child at


home with reading. This is also a great opportunity to ask any questions you may have about their reading homework. Please see the diary dates at the end of this letter to find out when your child's reading even is happening.


