Wrap around facilities

Please remember that all children must be handed over to a member of staff at our wrap around facilities before leaving the school site. Parents must not drop their children off and leave the school site without ensuring they are safely handed over to an adult in the morning. Please also ensure that bookings are made in advance as we are very busy. Similarly, if you do not need your child's place please notify our wrap around team so that a place can be freed up for someone else. All bookings and cancellations can be made through our school gateway app which all parents have access to.

Holidays in school time

Please note that holidays are **not permitted** in school time. Although we appreciate the costs are significantly less this does have an impact on your child's learning. When children return after holidays they have missed large blocks of learning which can be difficult to catch up. This can lead to anxiety in children as they struggle to make up lost learning. We are noticing the impact that this is having on our children who are absent from school during term time both emotionally and academically. If holiday requests continue to rise we will consider becoming a school that fines — this is something that we have avoided historically. Please think twice before requesting holidays as they are unlikely to be authorised.

We have extremely knowledgeable maths leaders (Mrs Haughey and Mrs Crozier) who have developed a mastery approach to maths over the years. Our Ofsted inspection praised our maths curriculum; "In mathematics, pupils regularly practice their learning and use flashbacks which ensures that they build their knowledge over time. Pupils enjoy solving mathematical challenges, which really make them think, and apply their knowledge to solve problems". Please do attend our sessions to support your child with their learning.
